Our History

Established in the year 1965 on July 22, Christian College Kattakada is located in the Poovachal panchayat area under Nedumangad taluk, 20 kms from the city of Thiruvananthapuram. Rev. Legg, the erstwhile Bishop of South Kerala Diocese, was the founder of the college. Started as a

junior college affiliated to the University of Kerala, Christian College is now looked upon as the outcome of the aspirations, prayers, sacrifices, sweat and toil of the SIUC community of the South Kerala Diocese. It was through a series of challenging ordeals that this institution came to attain its present status. Upgraded in 1976-77 to an Arts and Science college offering undergraduate courses, this institution offers today Degree courses in Botany, Commerce, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Chemistry, Zoology, History and Economics, and Post-Graduate courses in Botany, Physics and Chemistry. The college was accredited by the NACC in 2011 and was awarded a B grade. Christian College, Kattakada has had able academicians and administrators at its helm from the very early days of its inception.

The Rt. Rev. V. William, Most. Rt. Rev. Dr. I. Jesudasan, Rt. Rev. Dr. Samuel Amritham and the Most. Rt. Rev. Dr. J. W. Gladstone were the former chairpersons of the college. The Rt. Rev. A. Dharmaraj Rasalam, Bishop of the South Kerala Diocese, is the present chairperson and manager. The founder manager of the college was Rev.
