NCC CCK REPORT 2019-2020

The NCC Unit of Christian College Kttakada, belongs to 4(k) Bn NCC Neyyattinkara has 160 cadets. Before the enrollment there was an awareness program "VIMUKTHI" conducted by 4(K) Bn NCC in connection with the Excise Department of Kerala at Christian College Kattakada on 5th March 2019. Hon. DGP. Rishi Raj Singh inaugurated the program. On that occasion the firing range of Christian College Kattakada was also inaugurated by Col. Ajay Raj, Commanding Officer of 4(K) Bn NCC Neyyattinkara.





At this time Dr. Shyju GJ was the Care Taker and Mr. Dipin D was the Senior Under Officer of CCK NCC Unit. On 22nd March the NCC Unit celebrated World Water Day in presence of Dr. Vincent Joy, principal of CCK. The Unit also provided water pots for the birds foreseeing the upcoming summer season.





On March 30 the NCC Unit of CCK inaugurated the new flag post for the well-being of the college and hosted the NCC flag. On 15th June Senior Under Officer Dipin D was selected to the Special National Integration Camp at LEH (Ladakh). It was an one month camp.
