National Service Scheme activities of this academic year were started by the celebration of Environmental day. This year we conducted a variety of programmes in the adopted village. During the previous seven day camp, the volunteers visited all the houses of the adopted village of the Thottampara and listed the house doesn't have a jack fruit tree. This time the volunteers visited the house again and planted a grafted jack fruit tree at every house. This programme was inaugurated by college principal Sri. L.S. Paul raj and ward member A.K.Dinesh planted a jackfruit tree at the adopted village. This programme made great awareness about the importance of jackfruit tree and the importance of environment.

On 17th December the certificates were distributed by Ms. Shiji E, Program coordinator N.S.S unit 21B, Christian College, Kattakada.
